Mayor's Order 2008-21

February 1, 2008

SUBJECT: Design of the District of Columbia Quarter Dollar Coin

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 442(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(2), and in accordance with 31 U.S.C. §5112(r), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Establishment

This order establishes the District of Columbia Quarter Design Advisory Committee ("Committee") in the District of Columbia government.

2. Purpose

The Committee shall advise the Mayor as he works with the United States Mint to develop a reverse side design concept that is representative of the District of Columbia ("District of Columbia Quarter") to be included in the series of circulating commemorative quarter dollar coins to be issued in 2009.

3. Functions

The Committee shall:

- a. Solicit and collect public input on the District of Columbia Quarter design concept;
- b. Compile the public input into at least two, but no more than three, narratives describing concepts for the District of Columbia Quarter;
- c. Submit the narratives to the Mint according to the schedule prescribed by the Mint; and
- d. Participate further as requested by the Mayor.

4. Composition

The Committee shall be composed of the Secretary of the District of Columbia, Who shall serve as the Mayor's liaison to the Mint, and the three public members, one appointed by each of the Mayor, the Chairman of the Council of the District of Columbia, and the District's Delegate to the House of Representatives. All members shall be residents of the District of Columbia.

5. **Terms**

Committee members shall serve until the District of Columbia Quarter design process is completed.

6. **Compensation**


Committee members shall serve without compensation.

7. **Organization**

The Secretary of the District of Columbia shall serve as Chair of the Committee. The Chair of the Committee shall call all meeting of the Committee and shall Preside at all such meeting. Any staff work to be done for or on behalf of the Committee shall be coordinated and performed through the Office of the Secretary.
