
Pursuant to the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act ("DC FOIA"), D.C. Official Code § 2-531 *et seq.* (2001), as amended, enclosed herewith is a listing of the lawsuits which were filed pursuant to the DC FOIA, during fiscal year 2009 and defended by the Office of the Attorney General for the District of Columbia ("OAG").
